Steve.

I haven't had a chance to hook it up yet. I plan to use it in the following configuration. Head unit is a Sony cdx-c90 (Quad Burr Brown DAC's - 2 per channel) Channels 1+2 HP at 85Hz to a pair of Adire Audio Koda 6.1 for my front stage. Then Channels 3+4 LP at 85Hz to a pair of Mpyre Audio 65X (6.5" Subs) in the rear doors. I am waiting for the Mpyre Audios' to become available before I install the amp. Should be another week or so. the rest of the system is ready to go though and already installed. I have to say this is the best looking amp I have ever seen though. I have heard people say they think Brax, Tru or Tru copper series look better. I couldn't disagree more. For me this is exactly what I was looking for aesthetically from an amp. Understated and elegant I love the Old English text and the sparse front panel. Very old school which is the way amps should be in my opinion. The large text is great for reading in dark places (like the trunk). The mounting scheme is perfect and will look very clean. Also this amp just fees incredibly well built and exudes quality from the RCA's to the heat sink. Great job. I can't wait to get it installed. Thanks again for the super fast shipping. I will update you when I get this installed in a week or two.
